

## **ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT**

Launceston Road Runners and the Treggy 7 Organisers have given consideration to the environmental impact that the race event has on the surrounding environment and tried to address this impact following the **REMOVE – REDUCE - RE-USE – RECYCLE** template.

The runner's wooden memento has been made by a small local company based in Lifton, (Sophella Crafts – [www.sophellacrafts.com](http://www.sophellacrafts.com)). Individual plastic bags will not be provided. The winners trophies have also been sourced locally, (More Creative Solutions, Newport Industrial Estate, Launceston, (<https://morecreativesolutions.co.uk>))

All stocks of single use plastic will in time be replaced with an alternative e.g. cable ties changed to re-usable ones, plastic cups changed to paper wherever possible.

Designated bins will be available and runners are asked to use them accordingly in the Castle Grounds and the Town Hall. Each will then be sent through the appropriate waste stream for recycling.

It is important that each runner or spectator plays their part as well; we would ask that you do not drop litter on the course but hand it to a marshal or place it in the appropriate bin.
